

**FY 2021-2024 TIP Amendment #4 - STAFF REPORT**

Proposed Amendment #4 to the FY 2021-2024 Transportation Improvement Program is now presented to the Board of Trustees for consideration.

1. Modifies one project at the request of the City of Sylvania and ODOT. This project does utilize TMACOG-managed funds. The project is:

- a. City of Sylvania – LUC US 23 11.75 Interchange  
PID 105889                   \$3,354,358 – STBG/Local/Federal – FY 2021 – PE Env  
\$864,430 – CMAQ/Local – FY 2022 – PE DD

This project does utilize TMACOG-managed funds. The amendment adds an increase in project cost in the PE Environmental and PE DD phases. The added STBG and CMAQ to the PE and DD will come from the current CO phase amounts. No new money is being added to the project at this time.
