

Parks and Preserves
Parks and Preserves includes state, county, regional, city, and village parks; wildlife refuges; nature preserves; state forest; and other natural, recreational, and historical green spaces.

Oak Openings Region Boundary
Oak Openings Region: Located in Lucas, Fulton, and Henry counties in Ohio, and Monroe County in Michigan, the region includes oak savanna, dunes, bogs, prairies, swamp forests, and a concentration of unique, rare, and endangered plant and animal species.
