

**TMACOG Administrative Modification #11
FY 2018-2021 Transportation Improvement Program**

This administrative modification was approved at the Transportation Improvement Program Committee on July 22, 2019 and by the Transportation Council on August 14, 2019. This modification will add funds to one project, change fiscal years of another project, and change the funding source for another project currently in the FY 2018-2021 TIP. The first project is PID 99004 WOO North Baltimore Central Business District Enhancement. The modification will be adding an additional \$97,232 of Surface Transportation Block Grant (STBG) funding to the project. The second project is PID 98999 LUC Kilburn Rd Bike Lanes Phase 1. The modification will be moving the project from FY 2021 to FY 2020. The third project is PID 106163 LUC 280 2.81 Veterans Glass City Skyway. This modification is switching funding sources from federal to state.

PIDs 99004 and 98999 below utilize TMACOG-managed funding. PID 106163 does not utilize TMACOG-managed funds:
