PID 117233: This amendment will add the detailed design phase to the project in FY26 to the TIP. Construction will begin in FY27. This project does utilize TMACOG-managed funds.

PID 117677: This amendment will add the detailed design phase to the project in FY26 to the TIP. Construction will begin in FY28. This project does not utilize TMACOG-managed funds.

PID 122346: This amendment will delete the FY28 project and return \$2,990,900 in CMAQ funds to TMACOG at the request of the project sponsor. This project does utilize TMACOG-managed funds.

PID 122751: This amendment will add an additional \$240,400 in STBG funds and will increase the scope of the project at the request of the project sponsor. Adjacent to this project location, TARTA is installing a new bus stop at the first driveway into Wal-Mart and these additional funds will aid in extending the sidewalk by approximately 250 feet to close the gap. There will need to be additional right-of-way acquisition and extension of an existing retaining wall due to the elevation change of the adjacent McCord Road railroad underpass. This project does utilize TMACOG-managed funds.
