

A RESOLUTION
UPDATING LAKE ERIE WEST REGIONAL COUNCIL CODE OF ETHICS

WHEREAS, Toledo Metropolitan Area Council of Governments (now known as Lake Erie West Regional Council) is a voluntary association of local governments in northwest Ohio and southeast Michigan, organized on May 31, 1968, and established under Chapter 167 of the Ohio Revised Code and the Michigan Public Act No. 7 (EX-SESS), and has carried out comprehensive metropolitan and regional planning since that date; and

WHEREAS, Lake Erie West is a public body and therefore since each member and employee holds their positions as a public trust, they should act to maintain that trust ensuring the reality and perception that government is conducted according to the highest principles of honesty and integrity; and

WHEREAS, in recognition of these goals, the Governing Board has recommended that the adoption of a Code of Ethics for its members and employees will assist in achieving these ends.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Lake Erie West Regional Council General Assembly that:

Section 1: The Lake Erie West Regional Council updated Code of Ethics, attached hereto as Exhibit A, for its members and employees in fiscal year 2027, be adopted.
