Annual Work Program Completion Report (Agenda III – for information) – As a condition for receiving federal transportation planning funds, TMACOG is required to submit a Completion Report to ODOT documenting work accomplished between July 1, 2022 and June 30, 2023 related to our Annual Work Program. ODOT requires that the MPO Policy Board approve the FY 2023 Completion Report thus it is now submitted to Transportation Council for consideration prior to advancing to the TMACOG Executive Committee.

<u>CMAQ/CRP Scoring and Ranking (Agenda IV – for information)</u> – The TIP Committee recently held a solicitation for Congestion Mitigation/Air Quality (CMAQ) and Carbon Reduction Program (CRP) funding. The TIP Scoring Committee met to review and score the submitted applications and forwarded a funding recommendation to the TIP Committee. The TIP Committee reviewed and approved the funding recommendation at their August meeting for advancement to the Transportation Council.

<u>FY 2024-2027 TIP Amendment #1 (Agenda V – For Approval)</u> – TIP amendment #1 adds four projects (PID 116382 – WOO TR 110 5.4 (Glenwood at SR 65 Roundabout), PID 115418 – LUC IR 475 10.21 3rd Lane Add: Widen I-475 (east of railroad) and Douglas Road within the City of Toledo, PID 107405 - WOO Roche De Boeuf Interurban Bridge, and PID 117233 - WOO CR9 5.86 Lime City Widening), removes one project phase (PID 117233 - WOO CR9 5.86 Lime City Widening (RW)), and modifies one project (PID – 111533 – LUC CR 500 2.61 MLK Bridge Multiuse Path) on the FY 2024-2027 TIP.
