### 1. Welcome & Introductions

Ed O'Reilly called the meeting to order.

### 2. Approval of March Minutes

Steve Spittler moved to approve the minutes. Dan Becker seconded the motion. The motion passed.

### 3. New Business

#### a. Active Transportation Academy

Lance Dasher presented to the committee a training that will be occurring on June 27, 2019 at TMACOG. This training will be on Community Traffic Calming and Complete Streets Implementation. This will be the first of a series of trainings. The next will be focused on walking and biking audits, and the training after that will be on advocacy of active transportation or equity in active transportation. The registration will be open and forwarded to the committee.

#### b. Ohio Bicycle Summit

Lance Dasher informed the committee that he participated in the Ohio Bicycle Summit in Columbus. There were a lot of great presentations, but the event seemed to be focused on the Columbus area.

#### a. On the Move: 2045 Transportation Plan – Update 2020

#### b. 2019 Bike Month

#### c. US and State Bike Routes

Lance Dasher indicated that TMACOG has secured all of the required resolutions from our region for the US and State bike route system. Now we are waiting on approval from other areas of the state so that an application can be made for the state to AASHTO.
