

**NOTES FROM THE TMACOG  
SYSTEM PERFORMANCE & MONITORING COMMITTEE MEETING**

The meeting was held on January 11, 2021 at 1:30 p.m. via GoToMeeting virtual format.

- I. Call to Order** – Chair of the System Performance and Monitoring committee, Andy Langenderfer, called the meeting to order. Attendees included Stephanie Bartlett, Pete Bick, Brooke Biniker, Kim Coucher, Andy Langenderfer, Corrinne Lochtefeld, Babar Stelzer, Gary Stookey, Kyle Warner, Sandy Wiechman, Natalie Zerucha, Lisa Householder, and Marc VonDeylen.
- II. Asset Management – Pavement Condition & Bridge Condition** – The committee reviewed a second draft of the ODOT pavement condition trends for 2015-2019. As discussed in the previous committee meeting, staff updated the ratings to reflect resurfacing or reconstruction work that took place through the end of 2020 thus eliminating some of the poorer pavement numbers. The committee also reviewed bridge condition ratings for 2017-2019. Much like pavement, bridges have more ‘Good’ ratings than ‘Fair’ or ‘Poor’. It was suggested to update the map with additional road labels, as well as to provide a list of the poorly rated bridges for further review.
- III. 2022 Annual Work Program** - The committee reviewed the contents within three sections of the Annual Work Program for the upcoming (2022) fiscal year. These sections included Safety Studies (60123), Continuing Planning – Data Collection and Management (60510), and Continuing Planning – Modeling and Forecasting (61520). The committee was asked to review the sections and provide any comments or new items by the end of February before the first draft is due to ODOT in early March. TMACOG staff proposed updating a list of top crash locations every year instead of every three years. The list for 2021 will be ranked with an emphasis on crash severity.
