

**NOTES FROM THE TMACOG
SYSTEM PERFORMANCE & MONITORING COMMITTEE MEETING**

The meeting was held on March 9, 2020 at 1:30 p.m. in the TMACOG Boardroom, 300 Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. Drive, Suite 300, Toledo OH 43604.

- I. Call to Order** – Chair of the System Performance and Monitoring committee, Andy Langenderfer, called the meeting to order. Attendees included Stephanie Bartlett, Pete Bick, Jamie Blazeovich, Kim Coutcher, Andy Langenderfer, Corrinne Lochtefeld, Gary Stookey, Lisa Householder, and Marc VonDeylen.
- II. Fatal/Serious Injury Crashes 2015-2019**– The committee reviewed fatal and serious injury crash data for the years 2015-2019, including any 2020 crashes reported year to date. The data has been uploaded to an interactive map and into a Crash Analysis Module (CAM tool), which the committee will be able to access after the meeting, as well. Some corridors were identified that the committee may review at future meetings, including Laskey – Secor to Jackman, Talmadge – Sylvania to Monroe, Sylvania – Jackman to Lewis, Wynn – Bay Shore to Corduroy, and Central – Crissey to McCord.
- III. ITS Survey** – TMACOG last updated the ITS Architecture in 2016. It is recommended that staff review the contents of this database with regional stakeholders every five years to determine if projects currently in the architecture are still planned or implemented, or if anything else should be added or deleted. Staff has created a short survey that will be sent to stakeholders this spring. The committee reviewed the survey, no further comments were made.
- IV. Asset Management Plan** – Staff is working on a Transportation Asset Management Plan. MPOs are not required to do a Plan like the State DOTs, but it is encouraged. After a brief introduction about TAM Plans, the committee discussed the goals and objectives. There will be 4-5 goals and Lisa will finalize the wording of these statements for further discussion at the next committee meeting.
- V. Other Business** – A reminder that registration is still open for the Transportation Summit. This event will take place on March 27 at the Premier Banquet Hall, Toledo. The focus of the event is Transportation and Public Health.
