



# Stormwater Coalition Meeting Minutes

## January 17, 2019

#### **Welcome/Call to Order:**

Kevin Laughlin, Wood County, Chair of the Stormwater Coalition welcomed members and called the meeting to order.

#### **Introductions:**

Those in attendance introduced themselves to the group naming the jurisdiction that they represent. The SWC Attendance Roster is attached to the end of the meeting minutes noting members, partners, and guests present.

#### **Approval of Agenda and Minutes:**

Kevin Laughlin, Chair, waived the reading of the meeting minutes from October 18, 2018 and asked for a *motion to approve*. Jason Sisco, Wood County, *moved to approve*, and Joe Camp, City of Maumee, *seconded*. **Motion carried.**

#### **Approval of FY2020 Stormwater Coalition Annual Work Program:**

Kari Gerwin, TMACOG, explained and reviewed language updates and additions to the SWC FY2020 Annual Work Program. A copy of the updated work plan showing updates was included in the meeting packet. Clear Choices Clean Water (CCCW), as an ongoing program of SWC, is also included for approval by SWC. Kevin Laughlin, chair, asked for a *motion to approve* the FY2020 SWC Annual Work Plan as presented. Kevin Aller, City of Sylvania, *moved to approve* and Rick Hannum, City of Waterville, *seconded*. **Motion carried.**

#### **OEPA News-Changes to MS4 permits, Construction General Permit Resources & More**

Ohio EPA is beginning the process of drafting a new MS4 permit. SWC members are encouraged to provide feedback on improvements to the current MS4 permit during Early Stakeholder Outreach (ESO), which ends March 6, 2019. Mr. Mathews provided an overview of the current MS4 permit and reporting requirements.

Potential updates to the permit include, but are not limited to:

- Require updates on ordinances and regulations related to local enforcement of construction general permits
- Evaluate language regarding plan review and inspection to insure process and documentation
- Enforcement protocol for IDDE– notices of violation
- Addressing TMDL wasteload allocations through stormwater programs
- Ensure permit requirements and performance standards are consistent with federal requirements.
- NOI's to be submitted electronically with current SWMP.
- Annual reports to be submitted electronically.
- Survey storm water utilities in annual reports.
- Identify priority illicit discharges that require immediate notification to Ohio EPA.
- Update const/post construction regulations to be consistent.
