


  - Annual Reporting








### Illicit Discharge Detection and Elimination (IDDE)


- Difficulty meeting requirements for mapping and outfall screening
  - Focus of SWC through January 2020
  - October Field Day dry weather screening, source tracking, taking samples, testing for various parameters, new reporting requirementsout
  - New MS4 permit may provide clarification on requirements and reporting expectations






### **Construction Site Sediment and Erosion Control**



### **Post-construction**


- Most members are doing some level of postconstruction inspection and require maintenance agreements






### Pollution Prevention and Good Housekeeping (PPGH)


- More than half of members seem to be meeting minimum requirements for staff training and SWPPPs




### Summary – Next Steps




Does your jurisdiction require post-construction maintenance agreements for stormwater BMPs?


Do you conduct post-construction inspections to ensure stormwater BMPs were installed correctly?




Do you have staff dedicated to annual maintenance inspections?







In what area do you need the most assistance in meeting post-construction requirements?



### How often do you train staff in Pollution Prevention and Good Housekeeping?


