

FY 2021 Annual Work Program (AWP) Development TMACOG Transportation Department Highlights of Major Deliverables

- **Bikeway/Pedestrian Planning**
 - Complete an Active Transportation Plan for the TMACOG region.
 - Continue and improve the bicycle traffic counting program and review data.
 - Support Safe Routes to School planning efforts throughout the region.
 - Coordinate and promote Bike Month
- **Data Collection and Management**
 - Maintain and update traffic count database
 - Maintain GIS and socioeconomic data on the TMACOG website map and data portal.
- **Freight Planning**
 - Maintain and update as needed the inventory and map of the TMACOG Area Freight Network, a collection of highways, railways, seaports, and airports in northwest Ohio and southeast Michigan
 - Plan visits to regional freight facilities to understand facility operations, the freight movement network, and what transportation & infrastructure improvements are needed.
 - Evaluate the Detroit-Toledo highway corridor and plan for possible changes to freight volumes and patterns resulting from the 2024 opening of the Gordie Howe International Bridge, connecting the U.S. and Canada.
- **Long Range Planning**
 - Prepare the 2021-2022 Legislative Agenda
 - Provide information and assistance in support of the current 2045 Plan, including presentations, distribution of plan documents, and input to state planning processes.
 - Refine targets (and related measures of success) to be achieved through implementation of the regional transportation plan and Transportation Improvement Program.
- **Public Transportation Planning**
 - Rank and select projects solicited for S. 5310 funding
 - Update the Coordinated Public Transit-Human Services Transportation Plan
 - Support ongoing efforts of mobility management and other priority projects and initiatives
- **Regional Passenger Rail Study**
 - Work to move forward with the next steps in the plan to reconnect Toledo, Detroit, and Detroit Metro Airport by passenger rail.
 - Build partnerships with jurisdictions, economic development agencies, port authorities, the private sector and others in promoting the development of new passenger rail connections.

- Safety Studies
 - Post safety crash data by jurisdiction on TMACOG website
 - Provide a regional list of the top 50 crash intersections and segments to local jurisdictions.
 - Complete a comprehensive safety locations report for a local jurisdiction.
 - Provide crash diagrams and supplemental information to members at their request.

- Modeling & Forecasting
 - Collect and analyze the latest ODOT pavement condition rating (PCR) data.
 - Strategize and build a regional Transportation Asset Management Plan (TAMP) based on the information and data needs gathered in FY 2019 and 2020.

- Autonomous Vehicle Special Study
 - Partner with DriveOhio on a smart mobility project in Northwest Ohio.
 - Develop regional Connected/Autonomous Vehicle Policies.
 - Research and explore federal funding opportunities for demonstration projects

- Transportation Improvement Program
 - Monitor and Maintain the FY 2021–2024 TIP
 - Participate in the Ohio Statewide Urban CMAQ Committee (OSUCC)
