This modification will switch funds around in PID 105889 by increasing the CMAQ amount by \$1,604,800 and decreasing the STBG amount by \$1,604,800. This will allow for the funding of PID 111546 to be changed to STBG from being originally programmed as CMAQ. There will not be a negative impact on either project or either funding program as it is a change of the exact amount of funds within the same fiscal year.

This modification also moves PID 116993 from FY 2026 into FY 2027.
