Kendra Robinson is a fourth-generation aviation entrepreneur with jet fuel practically running through her veins and a knack for turning runway dreams into cargo-moving reality. After graduating from Cal State Long Beach (Go Beach!), she returned to her hometown to join the family business at Sierra West Airlines—where she spent nearly a decade learning air charter operations, and learning how to troubleshoot just about everything.

Never one to ignore a good market gap—or a chance to get her hands on a Boeing—Kendra launched InterJet West Inc. in 2015 with a single 727-200, a vision for high-volume cargo, and just enough caffeine to make it all work. With a nod from the FAA and full family support, she took off.

Ten years, four 737 and countless air miles later, InterJet West has become one of only six large-aircraft operators specializing in ad hoc automotive cargo across the U.S. and Mexico—and the only one proudly owned and run by a woman.

Kendra continues to lead with bold ideas, a collaboration style leadership, and the kind of determination you'd expect from someone raised around hangars, headwinds, and holiday-season freight.
